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### Relocation of Sand School and Horse Walker Approved

Owners of an equine enterprise in Tiverton, Devon are able to go ahead with the construction of their planned sand school and horse walker when their request to relocate from the previously agreed location was approved by the local planning authority.

Original planning permission had been granted in October 2007 for a stable building, which has already been completed, and the sand school and horse walker. Since then however, the owners had reconsidered the location of these and postponed the construction until the new site positioning was approved.

Acorus Rural Property Services Ltd submitted the new application with amended plans explaining that 'the relocation is due to a number of factors but the new locations will require less excavation of the ground to provide a level area for construction and will be closer to the existing buildings and facilities.'

Mid Devon District Council approved the development and full planning permission was granted in November 2009.
