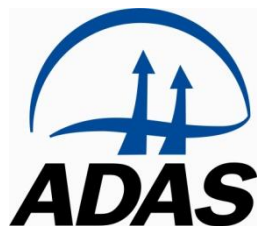


**Out-wintering Cattle on Woodchip Pads**
